Shrewton Cricket Club - Code of Conduct:



All *Members and Guests** of Shrewton Cricket Club shall:

Adhere to the contents of the *ECB Code of Conduct and Spirit of Cricket* policy (available on the club website). Promote the positive aspects of cricket, for example fair play.

Respect the rights, dignity and worth of every person within the context of cricket. Recognise good performance not just match results.

Treat everyone equally and not discriminate on the grounds of age, gender, disability, race ethnic origin, nationality, colour, parental or marital status, religious belief, class or social background, sexual preference or political belief. Follow the guidelines set out in the *ECB "Safe Hands" – Cricket's Policy for Safeguarding Children* statement (available on the club website) and any other relevant guidelines issued.

Not condone, or allow to go unchallenged, any form of discrimination if witnessed. Place the well-being and safety of children above the development of performance.

Display high standards of behaviour and refrain from using foul or abusive language. Ensure activities are appropriate for the age, maturity, experience and ability of the individual.

Encourage all participants to learn the Laws and Rules and play within them, always respecting the decisions of match officials. Respect children's opinions when making decisions about their participation in cricket.

Actively discourage unfair play, rule violations and arguing with match officials. Not smoke, drink or use banned substances while working with children in the club.

If a breach of the provisions or principles of this Code occurs or is reasonably suspected to have occurred the Club reserves the right to take such action as it deems appropriate, including but not limited to asking the person responsible for the breach to leave the Club premises. Any disciplinary or complaint hearings in connection with a breach of these rules shall be dealt with in accordance with the disciplinary procedure as set out in the Club Constitution. Not provide children with alcohol when they are under the care of the club.

**Members and Guests include all members and officers of Shrewton Cricket Club and all guests of those members and officers, as well as all individuals who watch, attend, participate and officiate in matches hosted by the club in whatever capacity.*

GUIDANCE ON YOUNG PLAYERS:

The minimum age for Open Age cricket is the U13 age group. Players must be in Year 8, and 12 years old on the 1st September of the preceding year.

Written consent is required for all U13 Players.

Bowling:

U14, 15	6	12

Batting & Fielding:

Duty of Care: Do not place the young player in a position that involves unreasonable risk, taking account of the circumstances of the match and the relative skills of the player.

Do not create the situation that places the opposition in a position whereby they cannot play cricket as they would normally do against adult players.

Batting helmets are mandatory for all U18 players.
